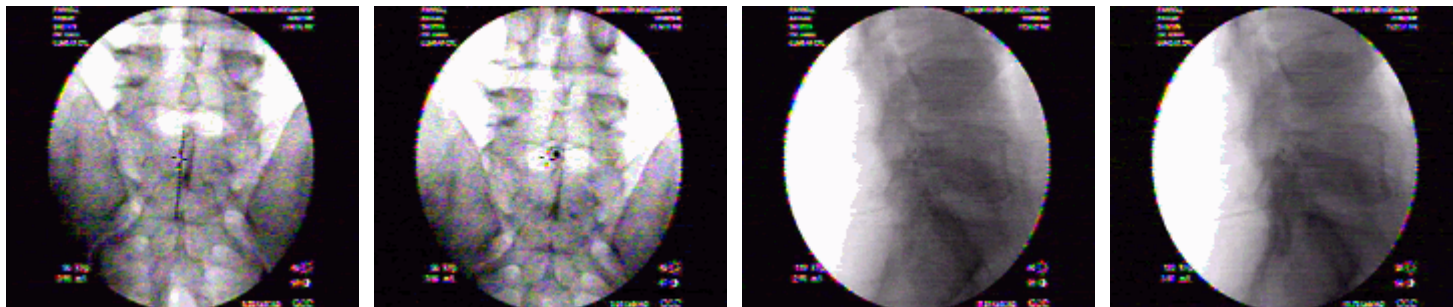

PROC. PERFORMED : EPIDURAL STEROID INJECTION 62331
EPIDUROGRAM 72275
FLUROSCOPY 76005

PROCEDURE : After informed consent, the patient was taken to the procedure room and placed in the prone position. EKG, blood pressure and pulse oximetry were monitored and remained stable throughout the procedure. The area was prepped and draped in the usual sterile fashion. Local anesthetic was infiltrated at the appropriate level. Fluoroscopic guidance was used to place a 20 gauge Tuohy epidural needle gently into the epidural space at L4-L5 using a paramedian approach. No blood or CSF was obtained on aspiration.

RADIOLOGY : Injection of 3cc of OMNIPAQUE showed spread of the dye into the epidural space on AP and Lateral imaging. The Needle was injected with Depomedrol 80mg with Bupivacaine 1/16th, 8cc total vol.
Patient tolerated procedure well and was transferred to recovery room. Patient was discharged home with escort. Discharge instructions were given.

POST-OP PLAN : I will see the patient back in my office in two weeks.
Continue p.r.n. medications as needed.
