The study is being performed to evaluate for arthritis, knee 716.96 based on the background history of DOE.

RESULTS:

RESTING ECG:

The resting electrocardiogram showed normal.

STRESS TEST:

The patient received an adenosine infusion at 0.14 mg/Kg/minute over a total of five minutes for a total of 10 mg. At two minutes into the protocol, the patient was injected with 12 mCi of Tl-201. The stress ECG was Non-diagnostic for Ischemia secondary to resting ST-T wave changes. The patient complained of dyspnea, headache during the stress portion of the test.

FINAL IMPRESSION:

1. Non-Diagnostic ECG for Ischemia.
2. Clinically negative for Ischemia
3. Nuclear images to follow.
